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**PART II**

**Resume**

**Essays**

The student shall write two essays:

1. Explain your personal, college, and career goals.
2. Reflections on your Chinese culture and heritage.

Submit the essays typed and no more than 1 page single space in length each.

**PART IV**

**Letter of Recommendation**

A letter of recommendation shall be written and submitted by a professional such as a counselor, teacher, employer, clergy, or coach, who has had direct contact and interaction with the applicant. In the letter, the professional should state the period of acquaintance, identify the relationship, highlight the applicant's attributes and character, and provide any further information.

The letter of recommendation should be submitted with this application form. The suggested length of the letter shall be no more than one page. The applicant may review the letter of recommendation and by submission, has agreed to its content.

**PART V**

**Transcript**

High School Transcript with accumulative GPA. Student Applicants should be aware that school records/registrar's offices are closed during the holiday season and may affect how grade confirmations are obtained for this application.

The **deadline for receipt of this completed scholarship application shall be, Sunday, December 31, 2023**. Late applications received after this date may not be considered.

**Scholarship Awards**

The amount of the scholarship is \$500 per scholarship recipient, depending on availability of funds.
